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Invitation to Bid (ITB) #2205 Ductile Iron Pipe and Fittings Addendum #1 and Acknowledgement

Subject: ITB #2205 – Ductile Iron Pipe and Fittings Addendum

As a reminder, all bids over \$100,000 must include a bid bond. Failure to include a bid bond will result in disqualification. This solicitation also includes a provision for payment and performance bonds. By submitting a bid, the bidder agrees to provide these bonds in a form acceptable to ACSA.

The red delivery deadline text in the Special Terms and Conditions Section H is modified as follows:

Delivery of all 24” casing, casing spiders, and casing end seals with accessories must be completed by November 1, 2022. 25% of each of the remaining materials must be delivered by December 1, 2022. The next 25% must be delivered by March 1, 2023. All remaining materials must be delivered by June 1, 2023. The bidder is encouraged to deliver materials as they are available. Failure to meet any of these deadlines by the successful bidder will result in the loss of compensation at the rate of \$500 per work day until delivery. Bids failing to guarantee these deadlines will be disqualified as non-responsive.

The Bid Sheet (Attachment A) has been revised and attached. Any bids not using the revised Bid Sheet will be disqualified.

ACSA may accept deliveries with a surcharge added at the time of shipment if:

- The bidder provides a notice from the manufacturer, on the manufacturer’s letterhead, justifying the surcharge amount. Surcharges should only cover direct unanticipated increases in cost.
- Surcharges shall not exceed the increase in the CPI-U from the date of the bid opening to the date of shipment. The CPI-U can be found at: <https://data.bls.gov/timeseries/CUUR0000SA0>.

ACSA reserves the right to reject any deliveries based upon the surcharge and terminate the purchase order/contract without penalty.
